

Getting paid on eBay

Learn more about what you need to provide and how the payouts process works.

GETTING SET UP

What to do

Add your checking account



When asked to add your bank account information during the registration process, select the bank log-in option or manually add your checking account.

Note: Managed payments does not support payouts to any PayPal accounts.

Make sure that the owner or business name on the bank account matches the name of the seller or business provided during the registration process. This allows eBay to verify your information and prevent payout delays.



Select when you'd like your payouts initiated



Daily: on weekdays, as funds are available



Weekly: on Tuesdays

GETTING PAID

What to expect



Step 1

Once the buyer has paid, funds show as Pending in Seller Hub. It's time for you to ship the order. Once the bank settles transactions to eBay, Funds show as Available.

Pending funds → Available funds¹ → Payout initiated within

2 Business days



Step 2

The payout is initiated daily or weekly, based on your selected payout schedule.

Normal bank processing times², typically within

1-4 Business days



Step 3

Your bank settles funds to your bank account within their normal processing times.

GETTING MORE

How you benefit



Predictable

eBay initiates payouts as quickly as 2 business days after order confirmation.



Flexible

You can choose to schedule payouts daily, as funds are available, or weekly.



Convenient

Pending funds can be used to pay for shipping labels, refunds, eBay Money Back Guarantee claims and payment disputes.
